NEW BUSINESS:

1. FEMA-Is travel/mileage to be covered under the training category.
2. FEMA-How to handle purchase amounts that are over the awarded amount.
3. FEMA-Once budget approved, can jurisdictions reallocate funds between categories.
4. FEMA-There are 7 jurisdictions that have outstanding fund issues, they were awarded too much money per guidelines: Springhill, Acadia, Lasalle Parish, Grambling, Grand Isle, Stonewall, Hammond.
5. FEMA-Issue with Washington Parish, they were underfunded (calculation error) by \$5,000.
6. FEMA-Lafayette City/Parish problem with application, part of application was missing when reviewed.
7. FEMA-City of Plaquemine will not need the 6 months of approved salary and benefits. Need to determine if it can be re-allocated or does it need to be credited back to fund.
8. AID TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT-Issue of Zachary having received money on behalf of Slaughter and now Slaughter wanting to go another direction with code enforcement. What to do with Aid to Local Government funds.
9. Beaugard Parish Aid to Local Government issue concerning their building inspection Department.
